# Statewide Candidates

- SPENDING CAP:** State constitutional amendment capping state spending so it can never grow faster per family than the rate of inflation.
- ABORTION BAN:** Ban on abortion except where it is necessary to prevent the death of the mother.
- SEXUAL ORIENTATION:** Pass a law protecting workers from sexual orientation discrimination. (Employment Non-Discrimination Act)
- LEGALIZE GAMBLING:** Legalize casino-style gambling in order to dedicate a portion of the revenues to property tax reduction or to increase money for education.
- MINIMUM WAGE:** Increase the minimum wage.
- DIVORCE REFORM:** Reform "no-fault" divorce laws to require mutual consent of both parties, unless proof of fault or abuse.
- ELECT JUDGES:** Continue the current system of electing Texas judges.
- BORDER WALL/FENCE:** A wall/security fence should be built on the border to enhance border security and stop illegal immigration.
- INTELLIGENT DESIGN:** Present scientific evidence in our public schools supporting intelligent design, and not just evolution, and treat both theories as viable ones on the origin of life.
- EMBRYONIC STEM CELLS:** Allow use of embryonic stem cells for therapeutic purposes.
- SCHOOL CHOICE:** School choice vouchers in inner-cities, which allow parents of children in failing schools to choose a public or private school for their children.
- CLASSROOM SPENDING:** Require at least 70% of taxpayer education spending to be used in the classroom.
- GUN WAITING:** A waiting period for gun purchases.
- MARRIAGE AMENDMENT:** Texas should ratify a Federal Marriage Amendment, which limits marriage nationwide to a man and a woman.

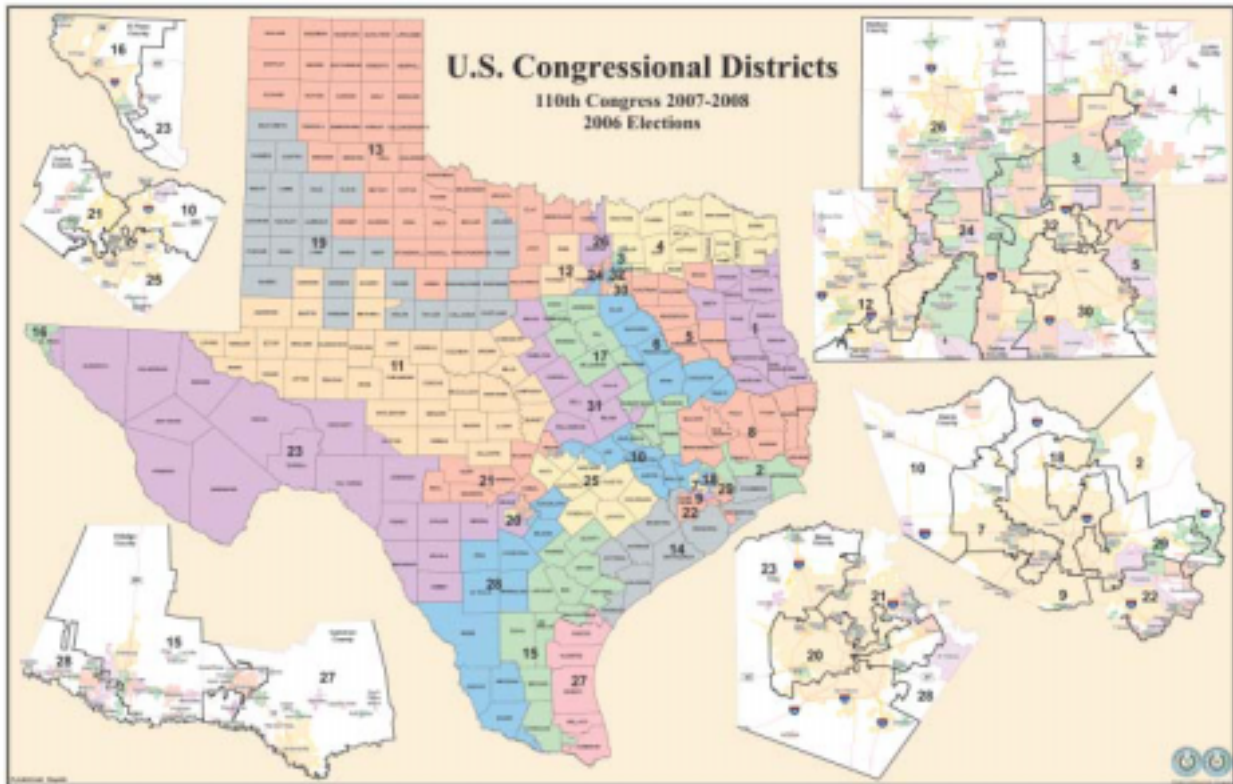

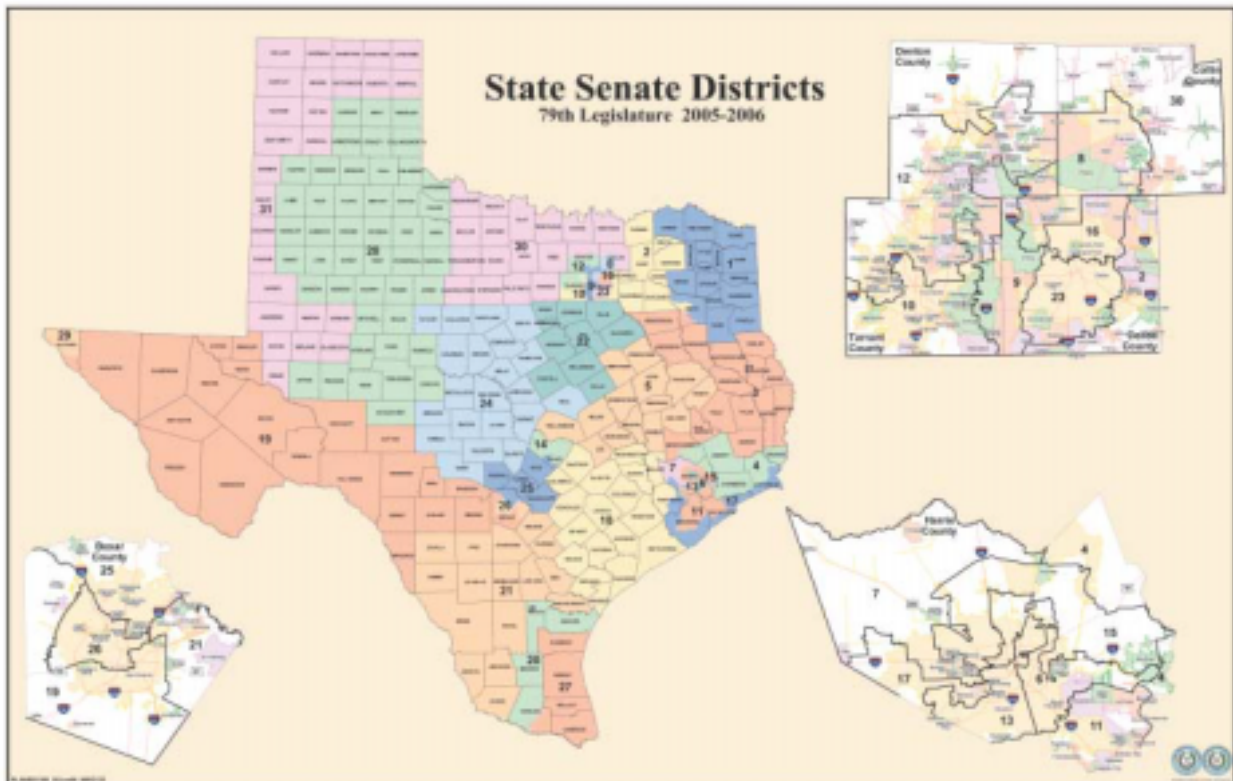

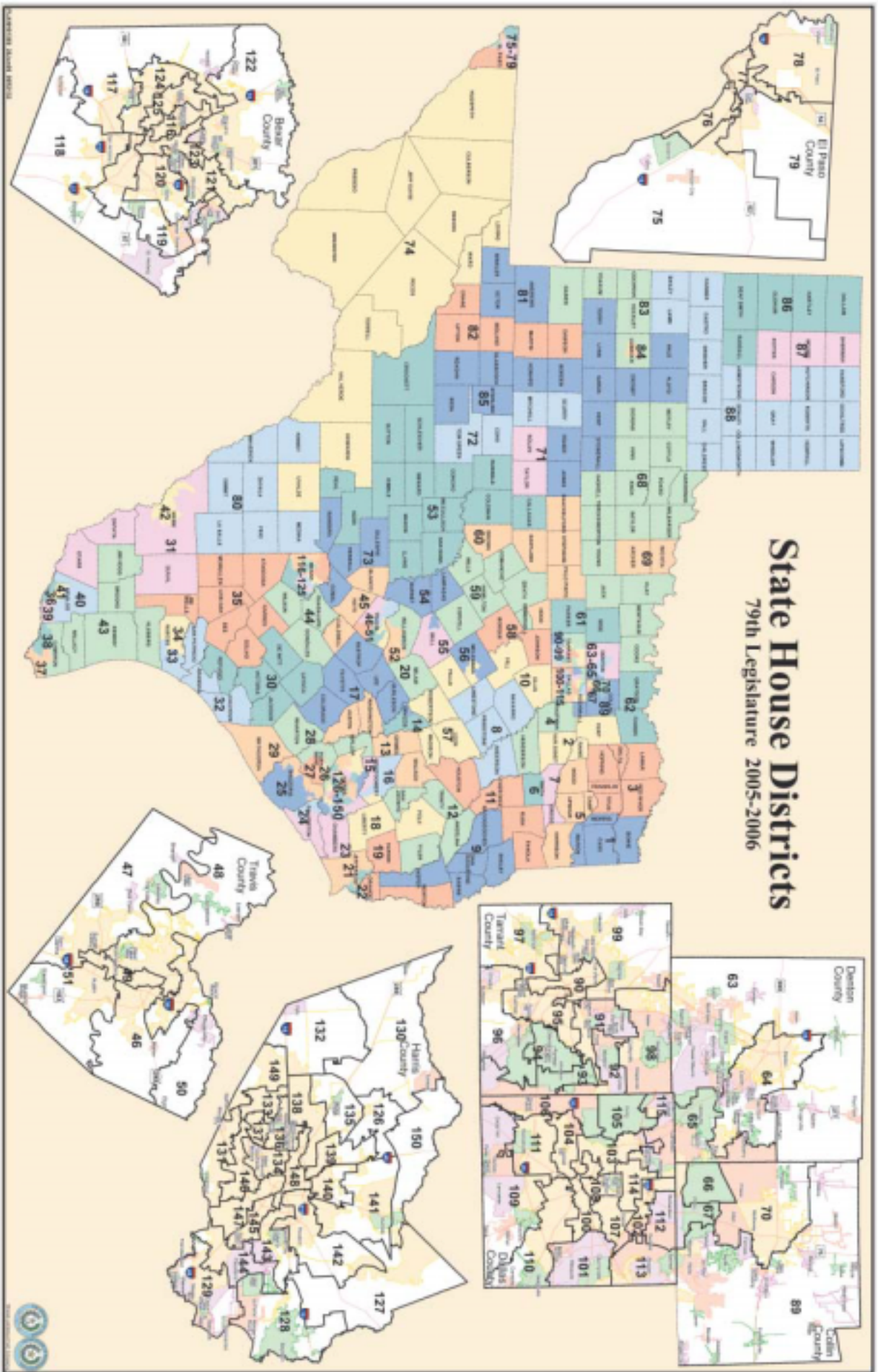

# State Board of Education

- INTELLIGENT DESIGN:** Present scientific evidence in our public schools supporting intelligent design, and not just evolution, and treat both theories as viable ones on the origin of life.
- SCHOOL CHOICE:** School choice vouchers in inner cities, which allow parents of children in failing schools to choose a public or private school for their children.
- SEXUAL ORIENTATION:** Add a law protecting students from sexual orientation discrimination.
- CLASSROOM SPENDING:** Require at least 70% of taxpayer education spending to be used in the classroom.
- BILINGUAL EDUCATION:** Curriculum should include not just English immersion, but bilingual education as well.
- PARENTAL REVIEW:** Public school employees should be penalized if they do not let parents review all instructional materials and records of their children.
- REPLACE ABSTINENCE-ONLY:** Replace abstinence-ONLY education for students with more comprehensive sex education.
- PRIVATE SCHOOL REG:** Regulation of private schools or homeschools.
- CHARTER SCHOOL CAP:** A cap on the number of charter schools.
- TAKS TEST:** A state mandated TAKS test, as opposed to allowing districts to choose the best assessment test such as the ITBS.
- TEN COMMANDMENTS:** Display the Ten Commandments in public school buildings.
- HOMOSEXUALITY:** School counseling or teaching about homosexuality.

# U.S. Senate & U.S. House Candidates

- REPLACE TAX CODE:** Replace the current tax code with a flat tax or a national sales tax.
- ABORTION BAN:** Ban on abortion except where it is necessary to prevent the death of the mother.
- TROOP WITHDRAWAL:** Bring U.S. troops safely home from Iraq immediately.
- SEXUAL ORIENTATION:** Pass a law protecting workers from sexual orientation discrimination (Employment Non-Discrimination Act).
- HALT NEA FUNDING:** Halt governmental funding of the National Endowment for the Arts.
- SCHOOL CHOICE:** School choice vouchers in inner-cities, which allow parents of children in failing schools to choose a public or private school for their children.
- HATE CRIMES LAW:** Hate Crimes law that punishes criminals more severely if their assault is on certain classes of victims (i.e. race, sexual orientation).
- EMBRYONIC STEM CELLS:** Allow use of embryonic stem cells for therapeutic purposes.
- GUN WAITING:** A waiting period for gun purchases.
- GOV'T CHILDCARE:** Increase governmental financial assistance for childcare.
- MARRIAGE AMENDMENT:** A Federal Marriage Amendment to the constitution, which limits marriage nationwide to a man and a woman.
- BORDER WALL/FENCE:** A wall/security fence should be built on the border to enhance border security and stop illegal immigration.
